5. THE YEARLY RAFFLE

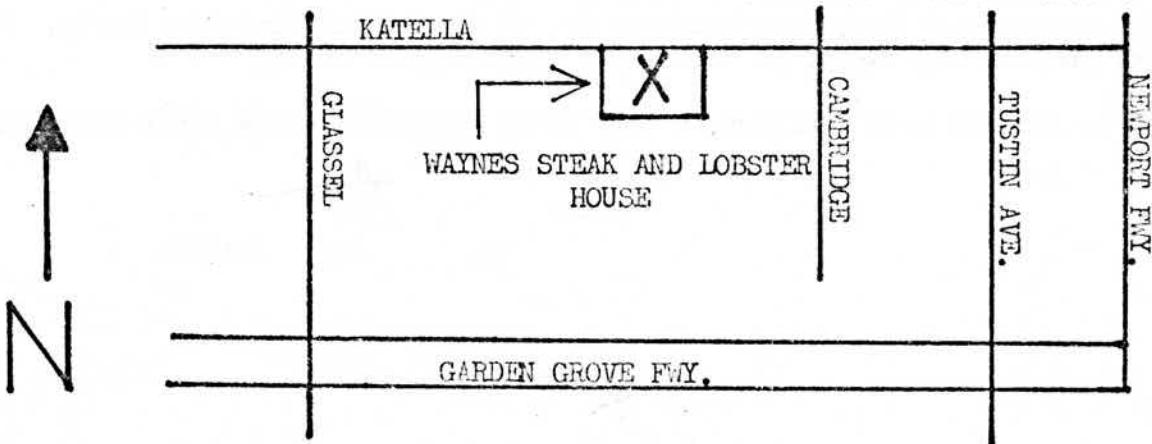
DINNERS Two fine choices are available: NEW YORK STEAK—\$5.50
